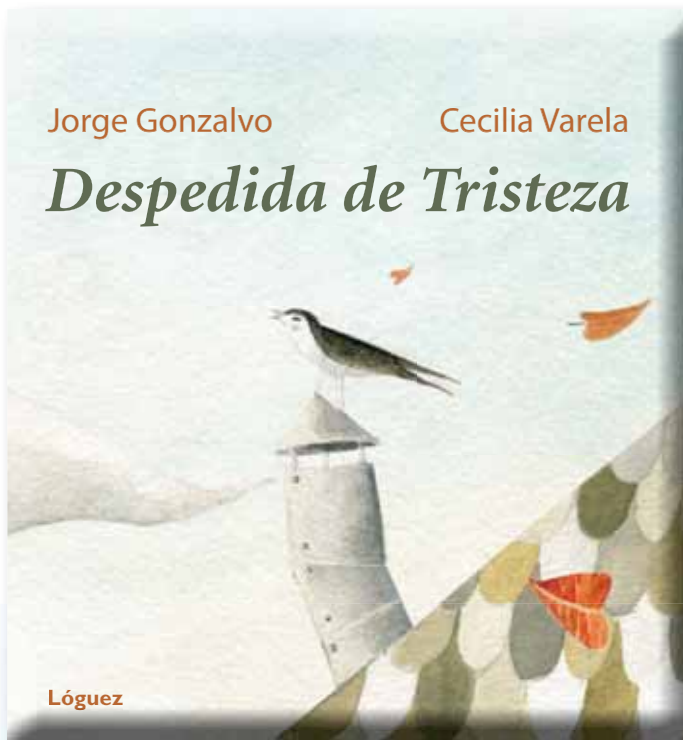

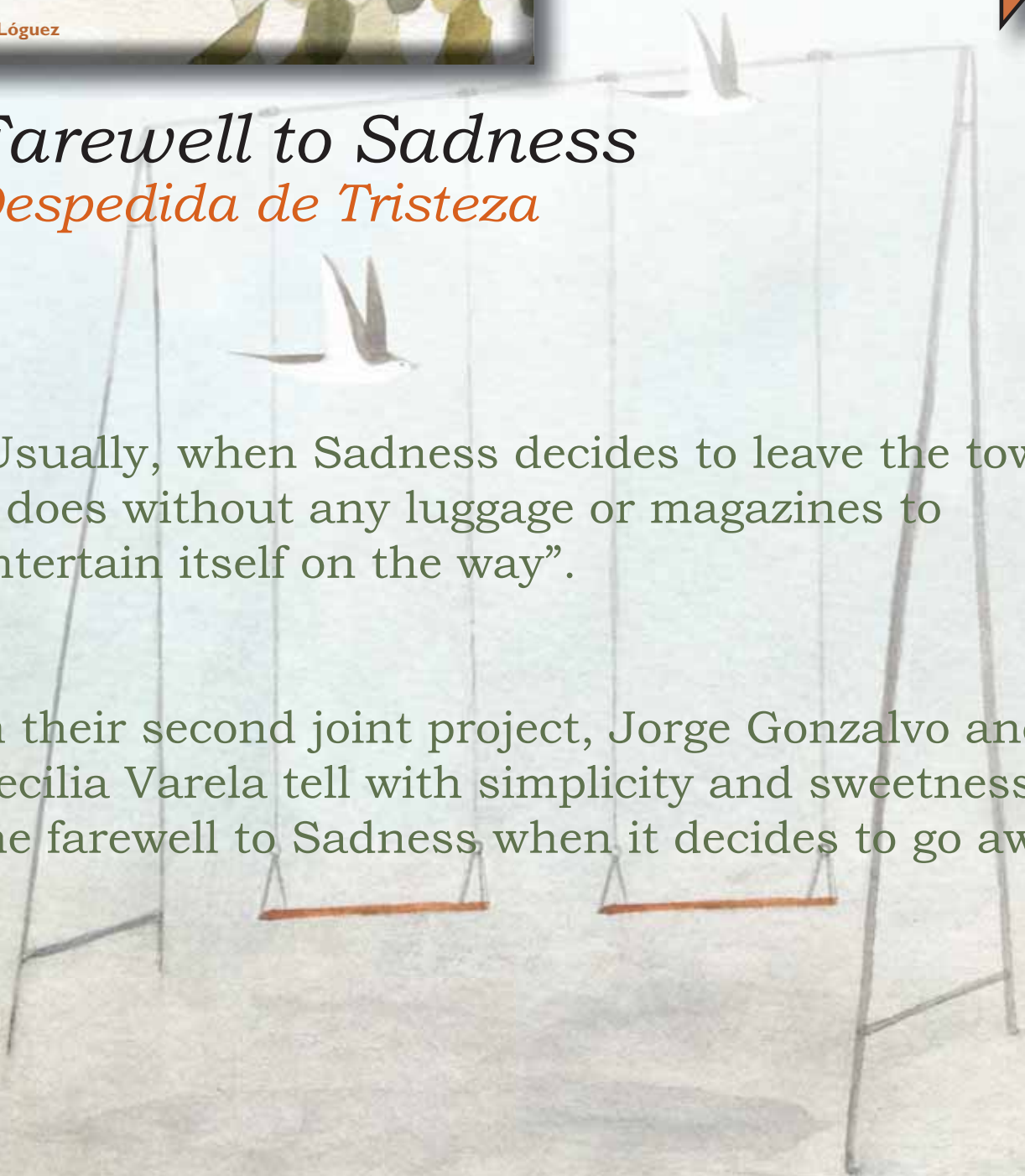

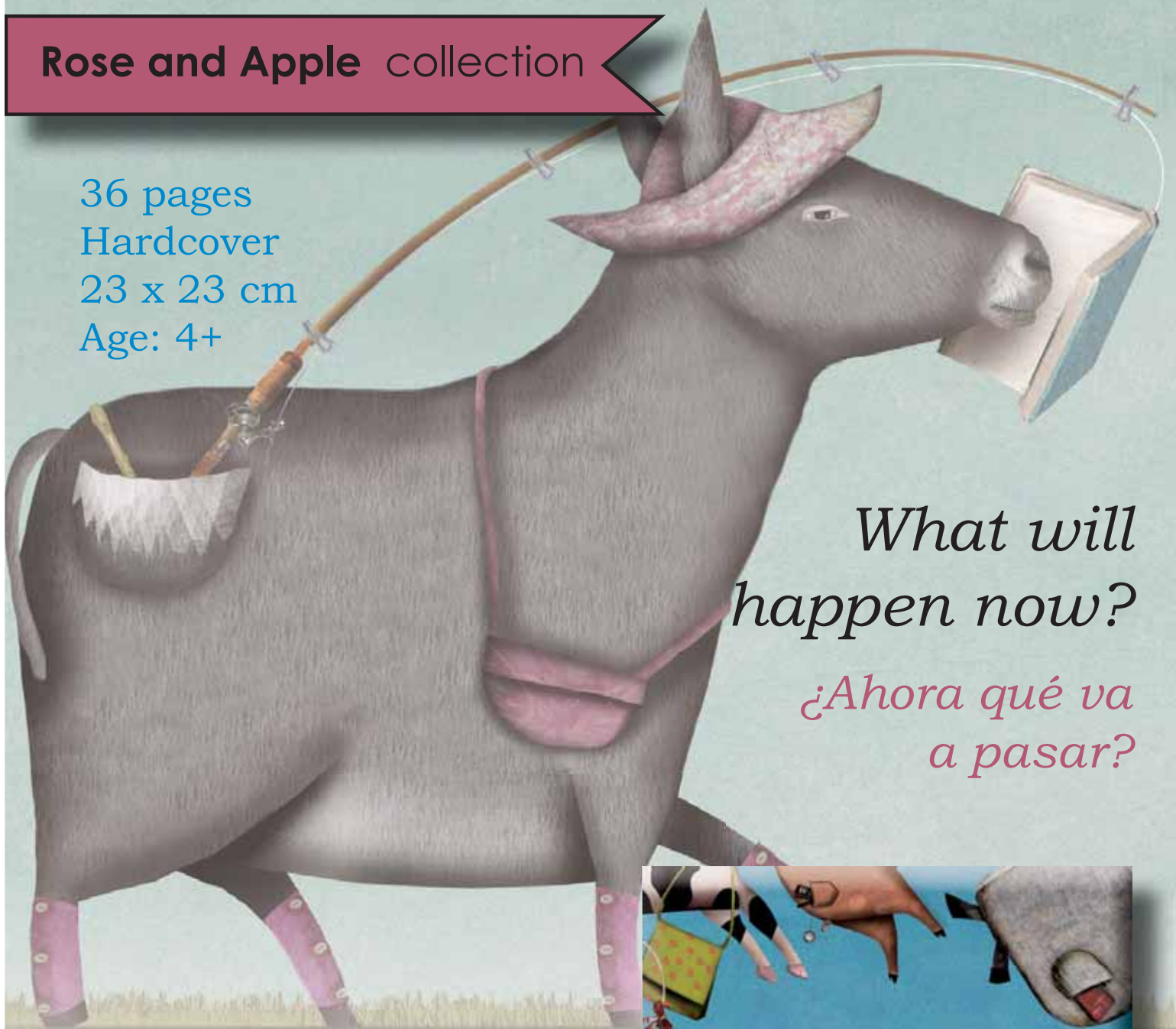
Every morning before going to work, Violeta's mom leaves a kiss on her pillow.
